

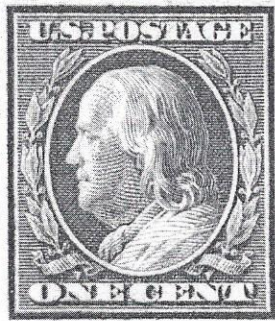
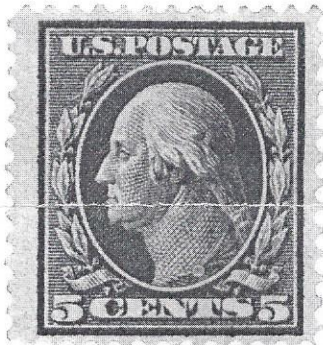
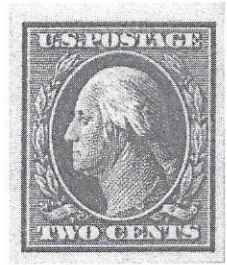


Washington-Franklins: There's No Need to Be Afraid

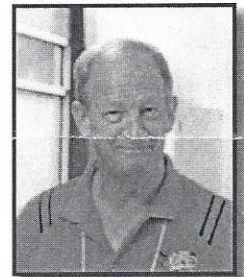
Learn how to:
