Military Postal History Society

The Military Postal History Society was founded in 1937 as the War Cover Club. Original focus was on the American Expeditionary Forces in World War I. The group changed its name in 1991 as it now promotes the study of the postal aspects of all wars and military actions of all nations. Today members' interests include soldier campaign covers, patriotics, prisoner-of-war mail, naval mail, occupation and internment covers, picture postcards of a military nature, camp cancels, field post offices, propoganda labels and leaflets, V-mail, and censored mail. The Society publishes a quarterly journal, *Military Postal History Society Bulletin*, as well as separate books such as the APO directory, and conducts frequent mail auctions. At NAPEX '01, see them at **Table F**. Dues for the calendar year are \$15 for US members, \$18 for Canadian membership, and \$25 for other foreign members (by air mail). Inquiries: Robert T. 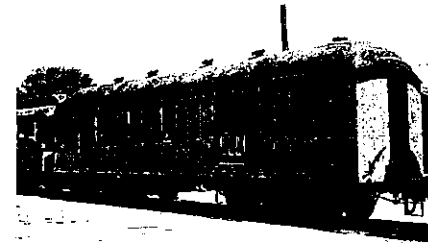

It soon expanded to focus on Railway Post Offices, and eventually to the enroute distribution and postmarking of mail all over the world. The Society publishes the *Transit Postmark Collector*, the journal of MPOS, which is currently in its 47th year of publication. The Society also published the *US Railway Post Office (RPO) Postmark Catalogue* and has other information for the collector and historian with ongoing research in several areas. At NAPEX '01, they are at **Table G** and are giving the Charles L. Towle Award for best exhibit in their area. Annual dues for membership in MPOS start at \$18/year.
